Asbestos Containing Material Notification

STUDENTS, EMPLOYEES, AND BUILDING OCCUPANTS

Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM) may be present in some University of Connecticut buildings. Typical asbestos containing materials that may be present in buildings include pipe insulation, spray applied ceilings, fireproofing, asbestos cement panels (e.g., fume hood linings, lab table tops), plaster, joint compound, floor tile, and adhesives. Buildings constructed after 1981 are less likely to contain asbestos products, though surveys are required prior to any renovation activity regardless of the age of the building.

Asbestos in an undisturbed state poses no significant health concerns. Before disturbing or removing any building material, verify its content by requesting a survey through Work Order Control at 6-3113. Any damage to ACM should be reported to Environmental Health & Safety.
